MISSION SUNDAY

The reading on Mission Sunday, remind us that it is always God who takes the initiative. In the First Reading from the prophet Jeremiah, the Babylonian exiles are gathered together by God (Jer 31:7-9). the Letter to the Hebrews reminds us that whoever is called to serve, it is God who calls: God takes the initiative (Heb 5:1-6). The story of Bartimaeus, The Blind man of Jericho (Mk.10,46-52), is also a 'call story.' The call of Jesus is mediated through others. Looked at through the lens of Mark's Gospel, the call of Jesus can come through his preachers and missionaries, even if their understanding is imperfect. It is God who takes the initiative in loving Bartimaeus and calling him to discipleship. His faith is a gift from God. Bartimaeus saw Jesus with the eyes of faith: 'your faith has saved you' Bartimaeus persistently resisted both the crowd and disciples in order to receive God's healing power mediated through Jesus.
