GIFT AID - As the end of another tax year approaches, we are now
preparing our gift aid claim. We thank all those who have already signed. Forms are available from
pastoral Centre. Any parishioner can sign a gift aid with the parish if:

- (a) You contribute to the parish via your parish envelope or by
Direct Debit
- (b) You pay income tax
- (c) Only a charity such as the church can claim this tax relief, which at present is 25p for every
£1 contributed
- (d) This claim will not affect you at all, nor affect the tax you pay
- (e) We don't have any access to your private PAYE details
